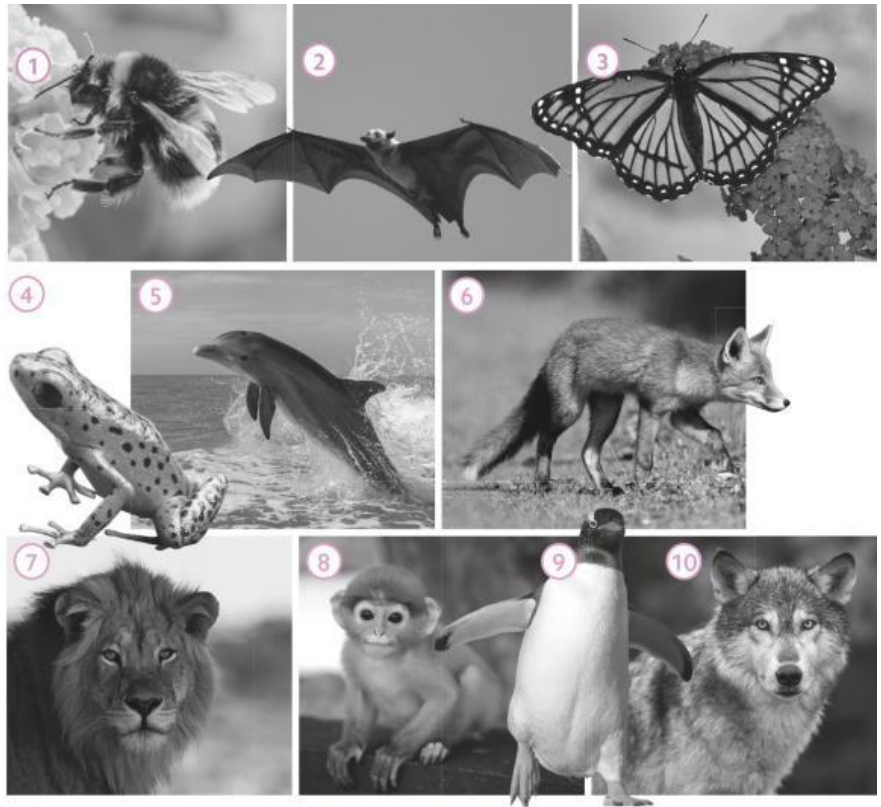

Sharks can be very ¹..... fish. They can bite and kill humans if they are swimming because they think they are sea animals that they hunt for food. These animals, like other fish, don't have fur or feathers, but they've got very ²..... bodies, without the scales that fish normally have, to travel through the water easily. When they are hungry they find big groups of fish and ³..... them from underneath. Some sharks can ⁴..... in both salt and fresh water, and the biggest sharks can ⁵..... up to 4.6 metres! They don't usually eat other sharks, but they sometimes ⁶..... each other if they are kept in sea life centres.
