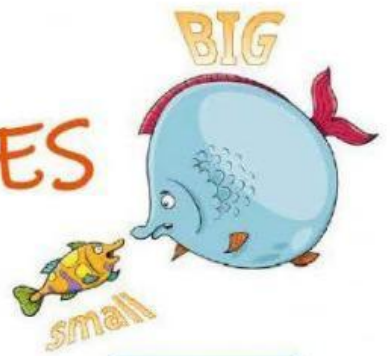

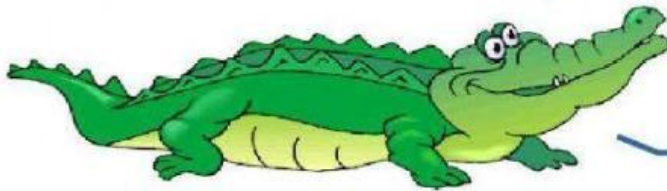
3. a CHICK is
