➤ How do we change this sentence into a question:

*My cat **was** lazy yesterday.*

***Was** my cat lazy yesterday?*

To form questions we put **was** before / after the subject.

Yes, I / he / she / it ___

___ you lazy?

Yes, we / you / they ___

___ he / she / it lazy?

No, I / he / she / it ___

___ we / you / they lazy?

No, we / you / they ___

We use the Past Simple with the following time expressions:
