Reading 2: A Family Vacation

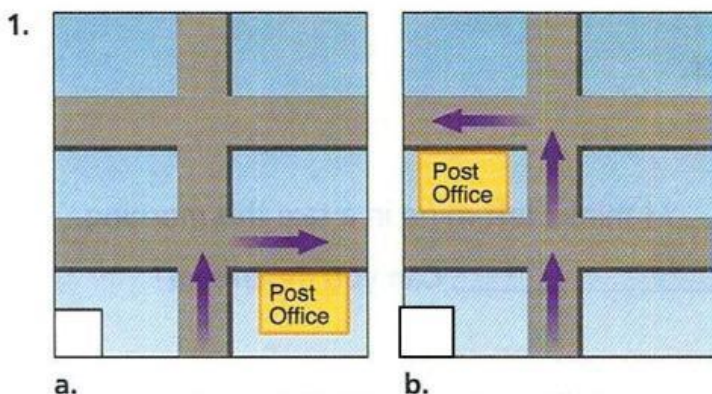
Read the passage and decide if the statements are true or false.

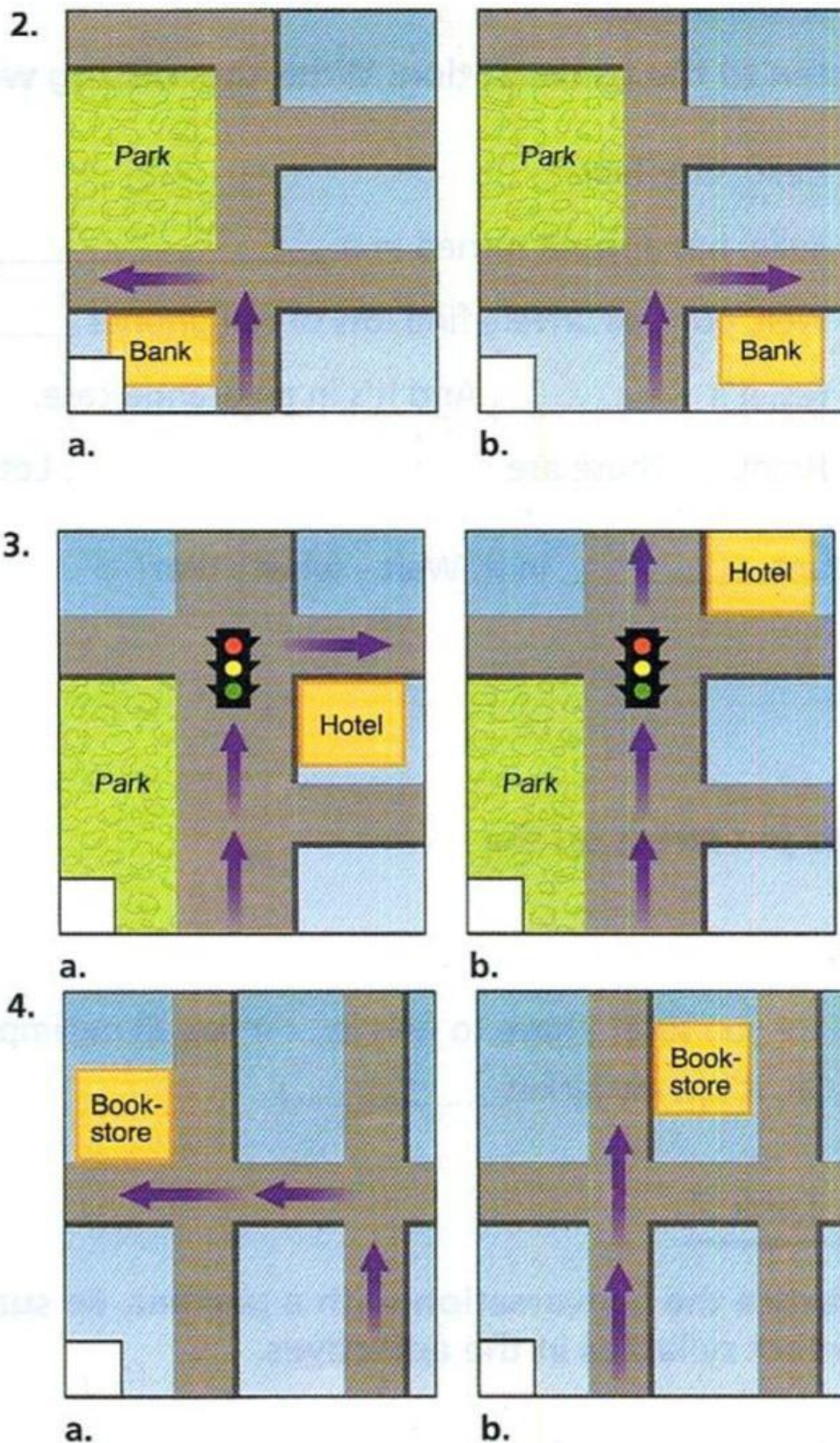

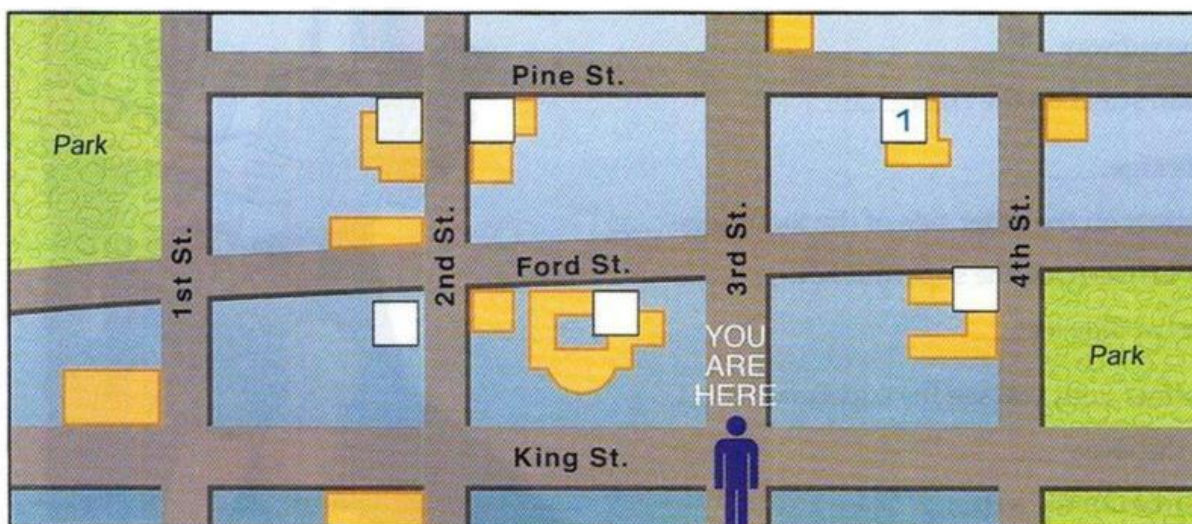
Listening 1: People are giving directions. Listen and check (✓) the correct map.
