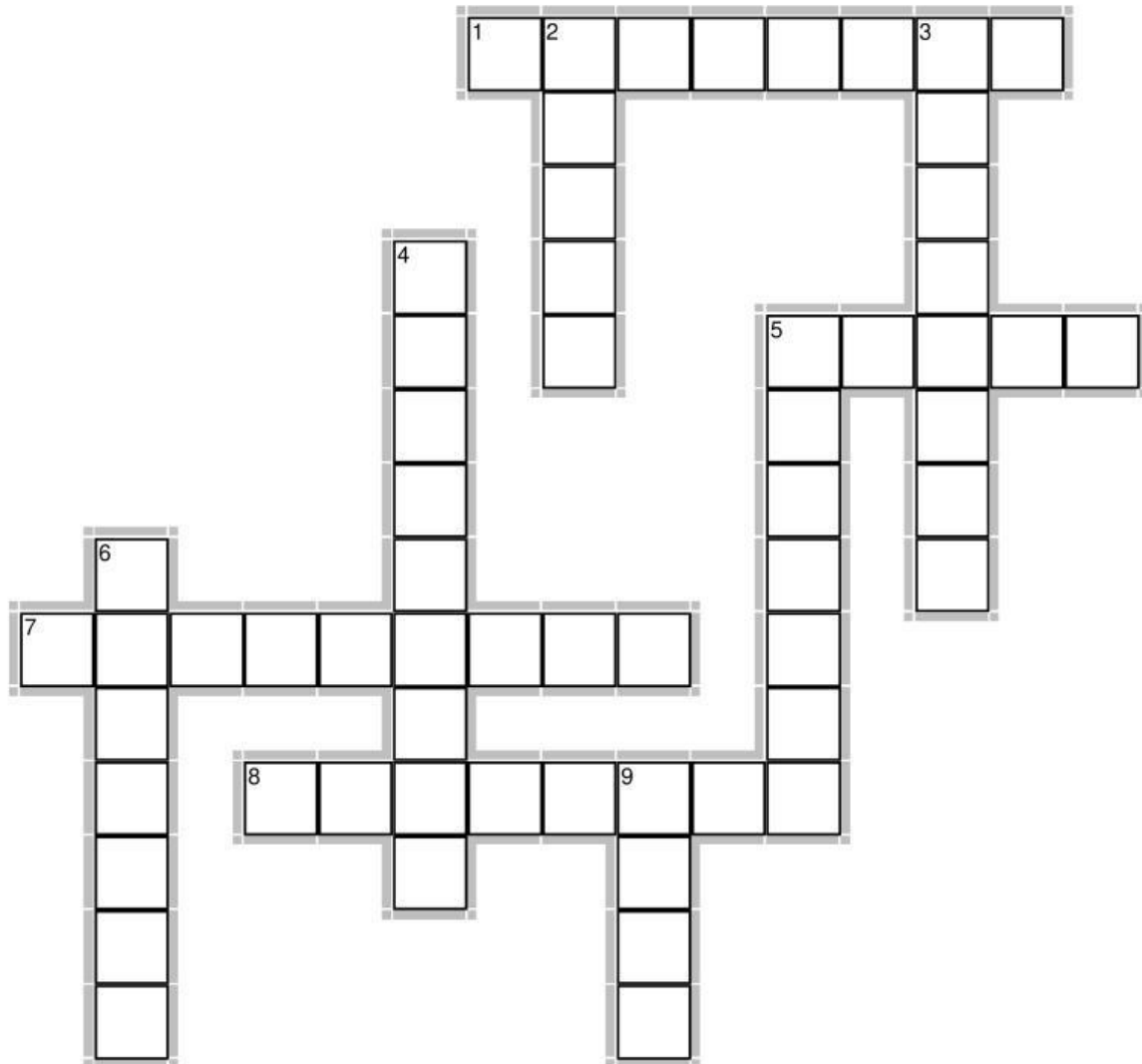


The Milkmaid and Her Pail Molly
