A. GRAMMAR: Present continuous for future meaning (*Hiện tại tiếp diễn mang nghĩa tương lai*)

- Cách dùng: Dùng để diễn tả sự **sắp xếp** hay **kế hoạch rõ ràng** hay lịch trình, **cuộc hẹn** trong tương lai, thường có **thời gian cụ thể**, và rất có khả năng xảy ra.

	Cấu trúc	Ví dụ
(+)	S + is / am / are + V-ing.	I am having a meeting with my boss at 8 a.m. tomorrow.
(-)	S + is / am / are + not + V-ing.	He is not working next week.
(?)	Is / am / are + S + V-ing? Yes, S + is / am / are. No, S + is / am / are + not.	Are you going to the party tonight?
Wh- questions	Wh- questions + is / am / are + S + V-ing?	When are we leaving?

❖ Note: V-ing: Động từ đuôi ing; S: chủ ngữ; is not = isn't; are not = aren't
