STUDYING IN THE UK

³ _____ (POSSIBLE) that you will be waiting longer. According to the 'queuing theory', the best line to join is the serpentine line. This is a long winding line in which you wait for the next available cash register.

If the supermarket has no ⁴ _____ (REGULATE) which would allow the serpentine line solution, you should choose the line on the left. The reason is very

simple. Around ninety per cent of the ⁵ _____ (POPULATE) is right-handed, and so they tend to naturally head to the right. This may sound like an old wives' tale but it's worth a try. On the other hand, waiting in line may not be such a bad thing anyway.

How to deal with anger

Anger is a normal, healthy emotion. There is nothing wrong with feeling angry when you have ¹ _____ treated badly or cheated. However, it becomes a problem when you express it in a way that harms yourself or others. So it is important to learn to deal with it the right way. One of the most important skills that helps you manage anger is self-awareness. This is the ability to notice what you are feeling and why. Another useful skill is self-control or, in other words, thinking ² _____ you act. Together, self-awareness and self-control allow you to have more choice about how to act when you're angry. Cutlery made from potatoes

People in Europe are increasingly aware ¹ _____ the negative impact of plastic products on the environment. In 2019, the European Union member states introduced new restrictions on some single-use plastic products. The aim is to completely ban plastic plates, plastic straws and cotton bud sticks, as ² _____ as plastic cups and fast food boxes. Scientists at the Gdańsk University of Technology ³ _____ already made their small contribution to a cleaner environment as they developed single-use cutlery from a special polymer. The innovative material is a combination of potato flour and corn. Professor Helena Janik, the head of the research team, claims that their polymer is cheap and biodegradable.
