Research has shown that men tend to have better navigational skills than women, but this isn't due to an 4) \_\_\_\_\_ advantage, as long believed. Published in the Royal Society Open Science journal, the study concluded that as kids, boys may have different experiences and opportunities that build navigational skills, such as being encouraged to play outside more than girls, making them better at mapping their surroundings.
