Crocodiles have long snouts, sharp teeth, and they are very good hunters. They have excellent eyesight! This allows them to see at night and to see while swimming under the water. Crocodiles also have good hearing.

Many people confuse the crocodile with the alligator. The crocodile has a v-shaped snout, while the alligator has a shorter, u-shaped snout. Also, when an alligator's mouth is shut, all its teeth are hidden. But, when a crocodile's mouth is shut, you can see some of their teeth.

Crocodiles eat almost anything, including pigs, water buffalo, deer, and even humans. They don't chew their food. Instead, they tear off big chunks of meat and swallow it whole!
