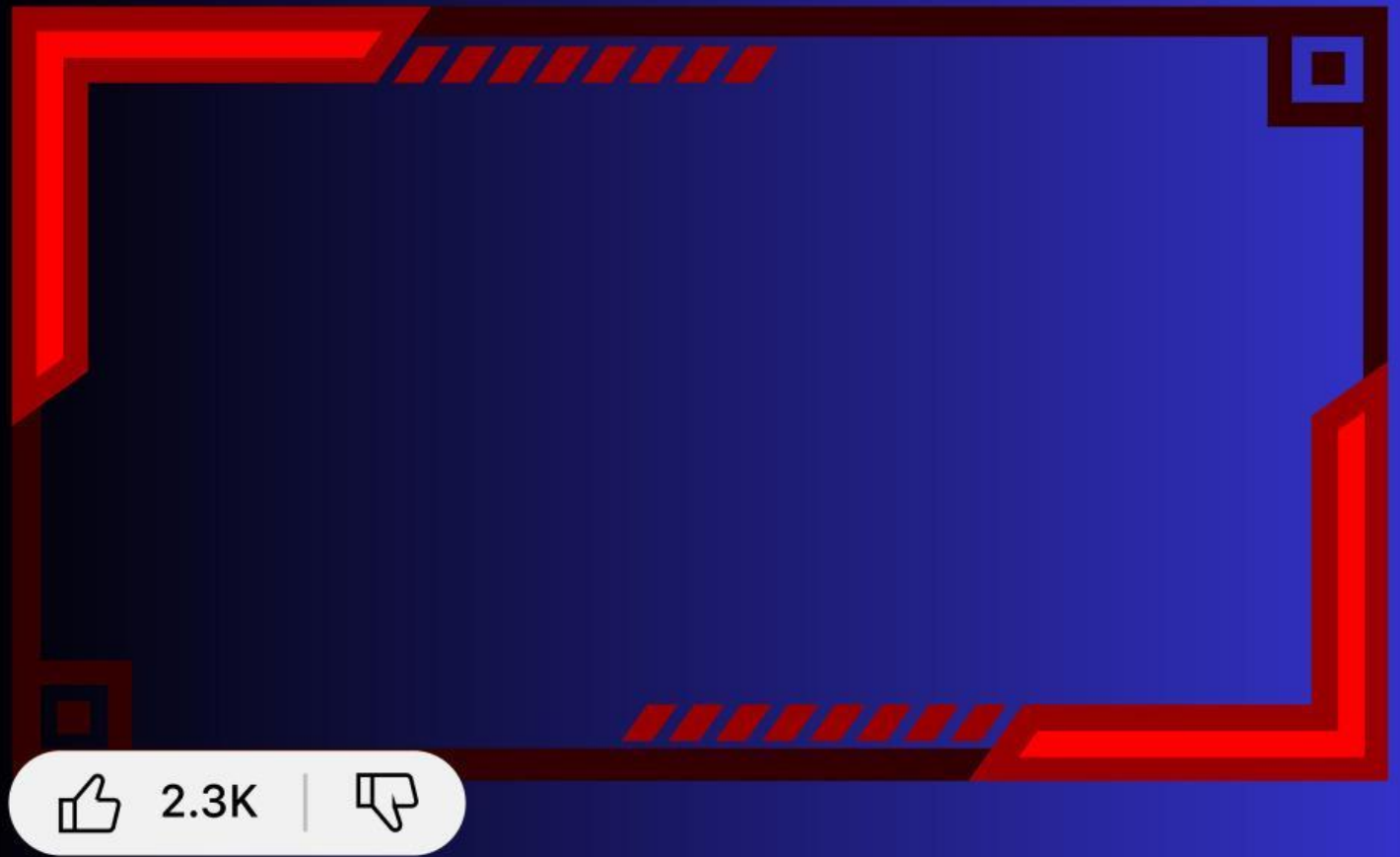


PREPARING FOR PRESENTATION IN A DISCUSSION TEXT
