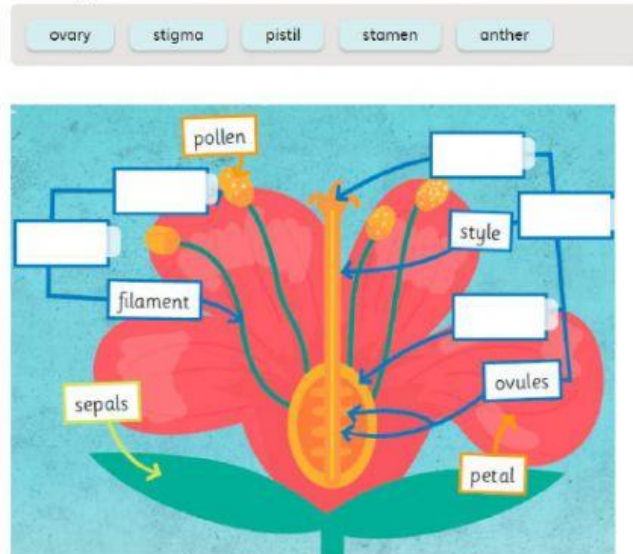


4. PLANTS (SEXUAL REPRODUCTION)

1. Label the diagram of a flower.



2. Order the stages of animal pollination.

When the flower withers and dies, the seeds are spread and new plants grow.

They transport it from the stamen to the pistil of the same plant or other plants.

Insects and small birds visit a flower and pick up pollen.

The fertilised ovule develops into a seed.

Some of the pollen sticks to the stigma.

From here it travels down through the style to the ovary and fertilises the ovules.



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
