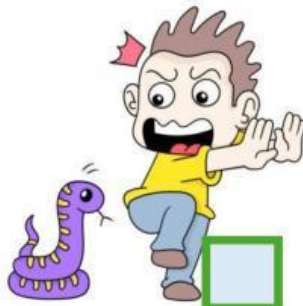


Present Simple Negative
