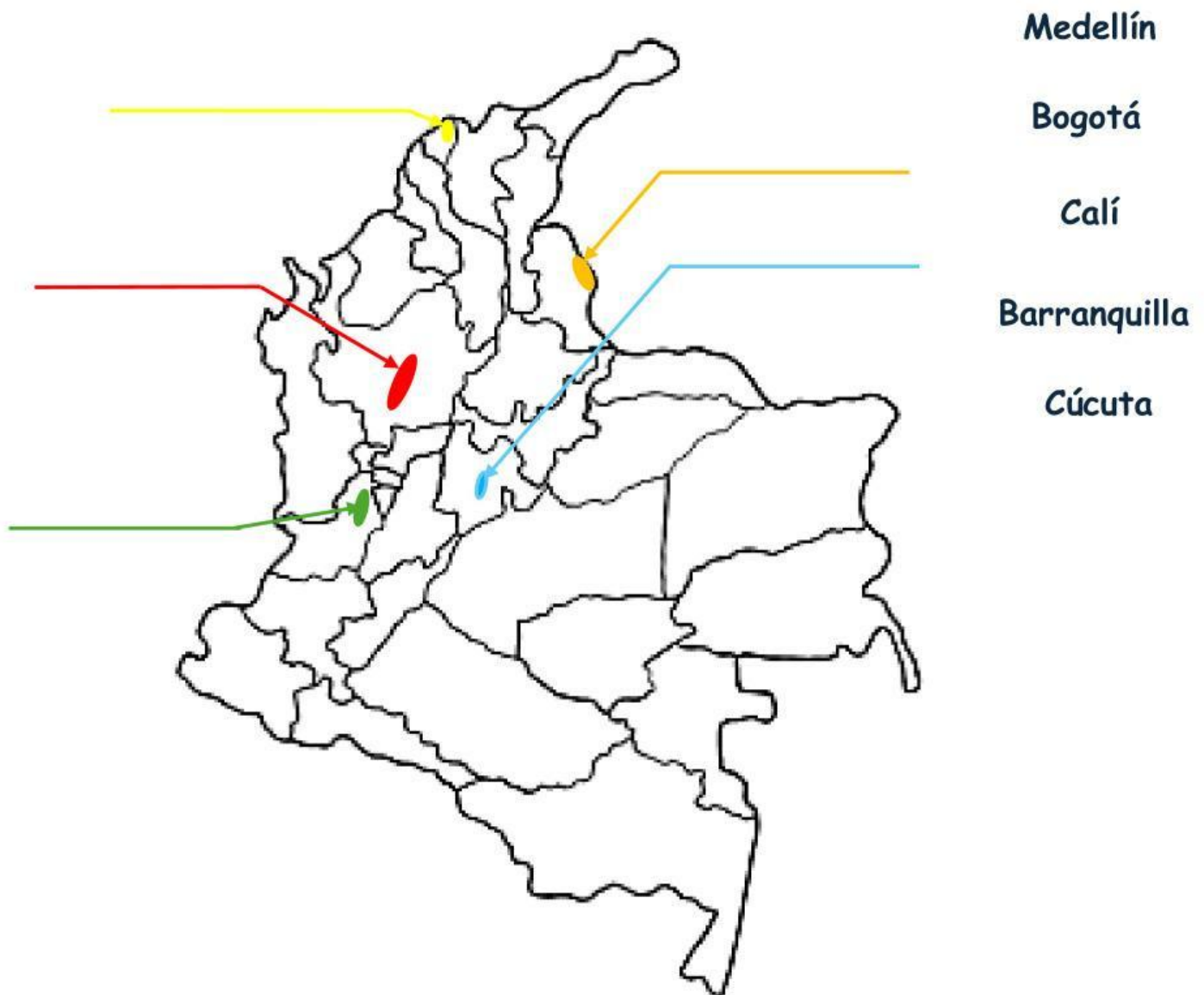


METROPOLITAN AREAS IN COLOMBIA
