

## MUARO JAMBI TEMPLE

Muaro Jambi Temple is considered one of the richest archaeological sites on the island of Sumatra. The eight temple-like structures appear to be Buddhist, and were probably built around the 14th century.

Archaeologists conclude that the site was the center of Old Jambi, the capital of the ancient Malay kingdom which reigned supreme about ten centuries ago. The capital was sieged and destroyed in 1377 by armies from Burma. For centuries, the site had been lost and forgotten deep in the jungle, only to be rediscovered in 1920 by a British military expedition team.

Muaro Jambi temple complex covers an area of 12 km<sup>2</sup>, along the side of Batanghari river. There are eight main temples in the complex. All of them are located in the center area, fortified by walls. Three of them are already renovated.

In 1982, a 32-centimeters tall female bronze statue was found at Koto Kandis, in the Muara Sabak sub district. It is believed to be the goddess Laksmi, holding a lotus bud in her left. In addition to the archaeological sites, many visitors find the riverside an ideal recreation and picnic spot.

## Kasepuhan Keraton

The Kasepuhan Keraton (Palace) is located in the sub-district of Lemahwungkuk in the City of Cirebon, built by Prince Mas Mochammad Arifin II in 1529. This is, therefore, the oldest palace in Java with the longest history. All royal families of Cirebon still live on until today, but all are now, of course, subjects of the Republic of Indonesia.

Standing on a total land area of 10 hectares, the Kasepuhan Keraton is the largest, most impressive and best kept among the Cirebon palaces, where every niche carries its own historic significance. The inner buildings are all painted white where the throne room, living rooms of the royal household, and reception areas to meet guests are found. The palace stands on the south side facing the large green square where the Sang Cipta Rasa Grand Mosque stands on the western side.

Another interesting feature of the palace is the Lawang Sanga building located on its south side, directly on the banks of Krayan River. This is the tax and customs office during the reign of the Cirebon Kingdom.

All goods from overseas entering the kingdom must pass the Krayan River where the king's officials will levy the necessary customs duty. This building is most significant for the wealth and welfare of the kingdom.

## How to Make Compost

### Tools and materials:

- Green bins (organic waste, leaves, sawdust, straw)
- Brown bins (manure)
- Tubs or large plastic drums
- Water
- Soil
- Burlap sacks
- EM solution

### Steps:

- Make a layer of organic waste
- Make a second layer with brown bins
- Repeat steps 1 and 2 until the drum fully
- If it is full, close the drum using burlap sacks
- After the seventh day, open and stir the compost. Then close it. Do this step once every seven days.
- To speed up the composting process, we can add the EM solution that can be bought at the farm shop store
- After 4-6 weeks, if the fertilizer mixture has turned blackish and no longer smelly, it means the composting process has finished.

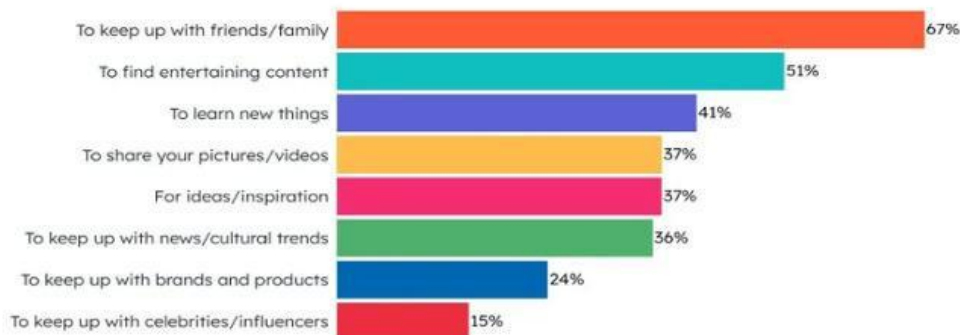
