

Listening & Communication Test: Applying for a Job

This test evaluates students' **listening comprehension and communication skills** in a **job application scenario**. The test includes **multiple-choice questions** and **dialogue-based communication exercises** using key vocabulary related to job applications.

Part 1: Listening Comprehension (Questions 16–22)

Audio Script: *(A student applies for a part-time job at a company.)*

Interviewer: Good morning. Please have a seat. Can you tell me your name and a little about yourself?

Student: Good morning! My name is Somchai. I am a hardworking and punctual person. I am also friendly and patient.

Interviewer: That's great! Do you have any work experience?

Student: Yes, I worked as a sales assistant at a small shop last summer. I helped customers and handled payments.

Interviewer: That's good experience! Why do you want to work for our company?

Student: I am interested in customer service and learning more about sales. I also like the job description and think I can do it well.

Interviewer: What are your qualifications?

Interviewer: What salary do you expect?

Student: I am open to discussing the offer, but I hope for a fair salary based on my experience.

Interviewer: Thank you, Somchai. We will contact you soon.
