Read the passage carefully and choose the best answer A, B, C or D to fill in each blank.

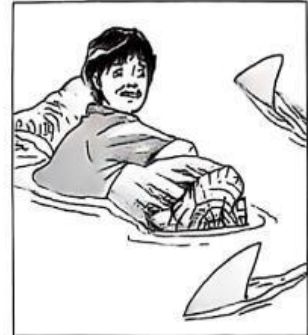
A Terrifying Experience
