It is a funny TV programme or short film that draws the characters instead of the real ones

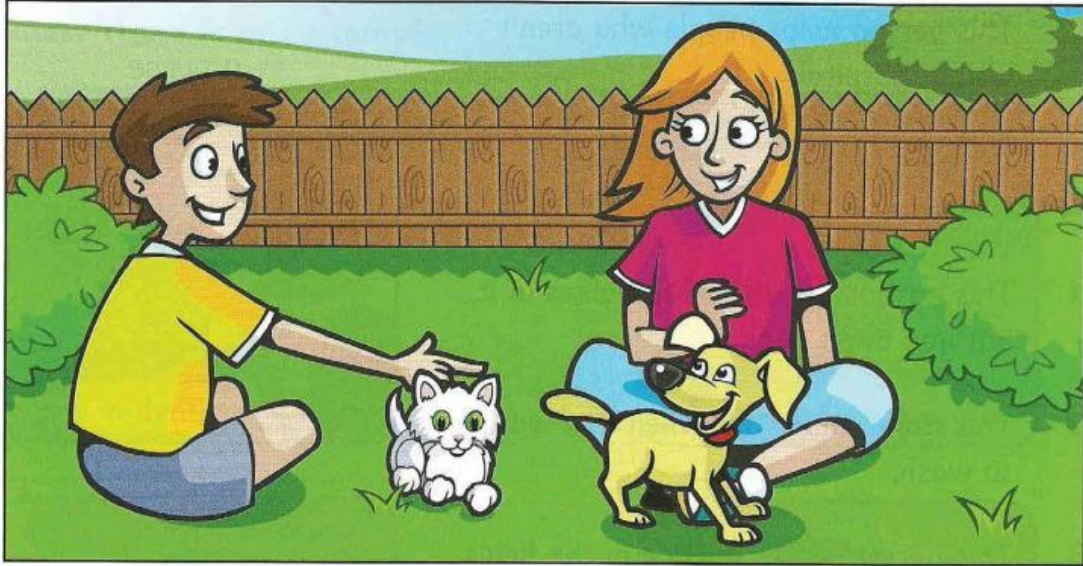
A TV show that is funny and makes people laugh.
