

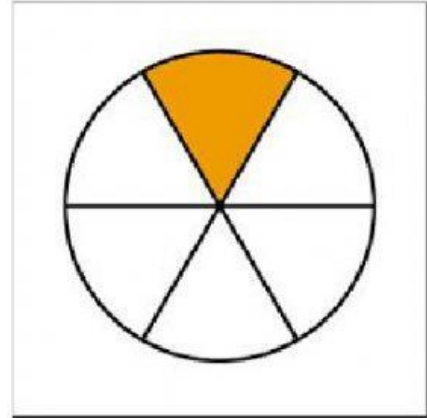
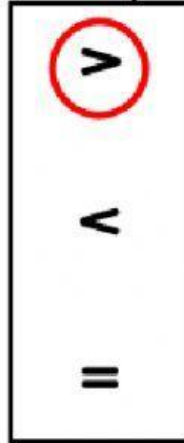
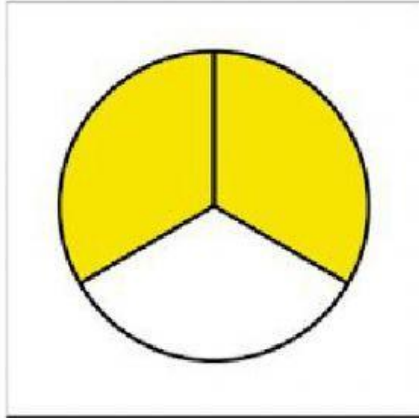
Comparing Fractions Worksheet

The alligator wants the bigger piece!

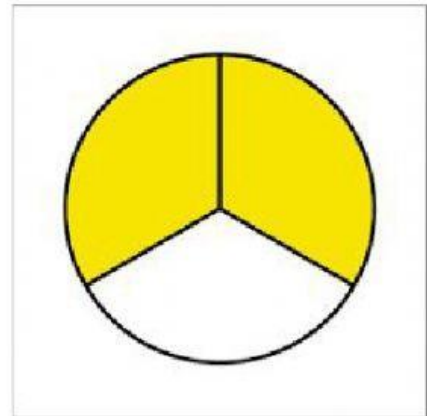
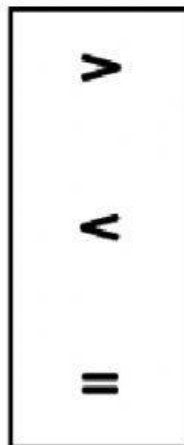
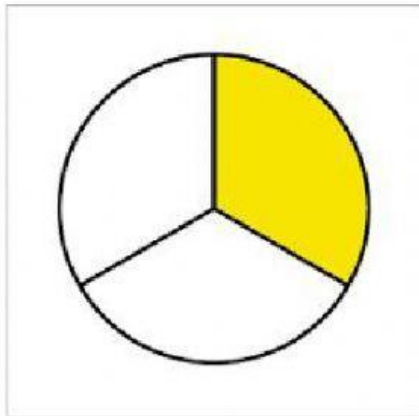
Remember: the smaller the number, the bigger the piece :-)

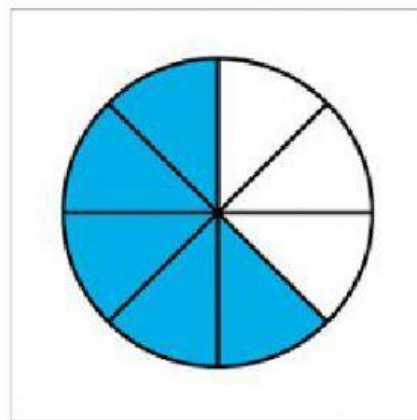
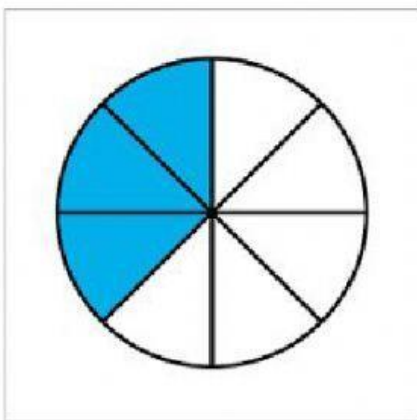
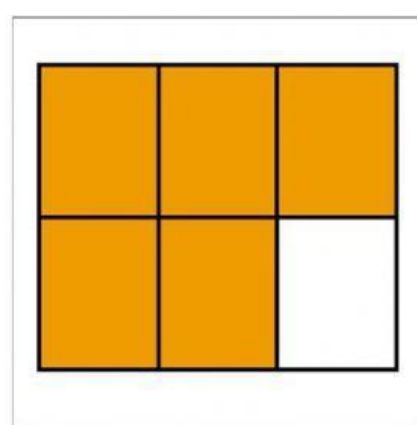
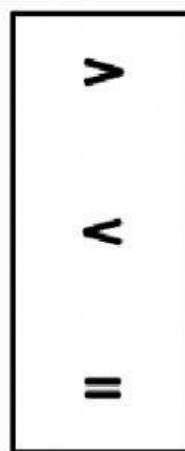
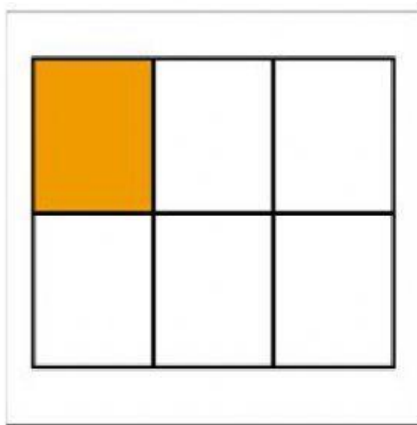
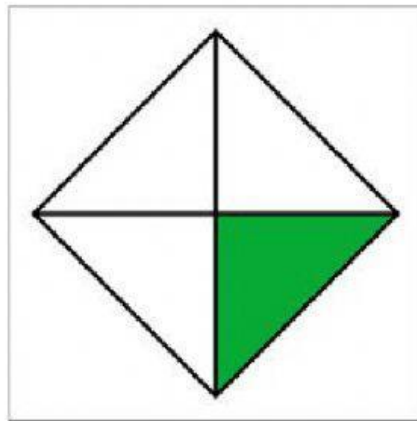
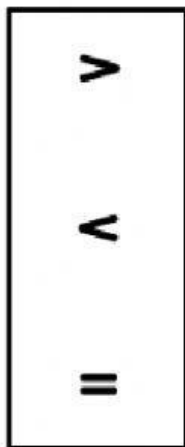
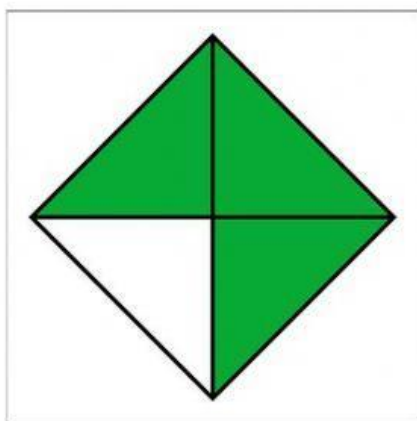

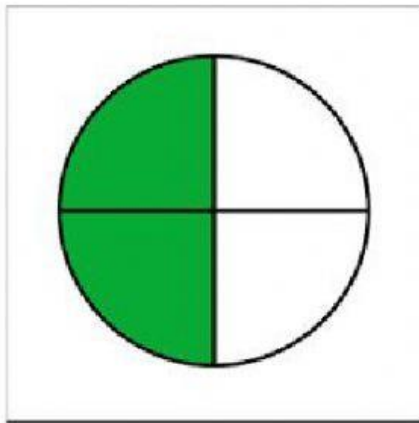


$\frac{2}{3}$ is greater than $\frac{1}{6}$

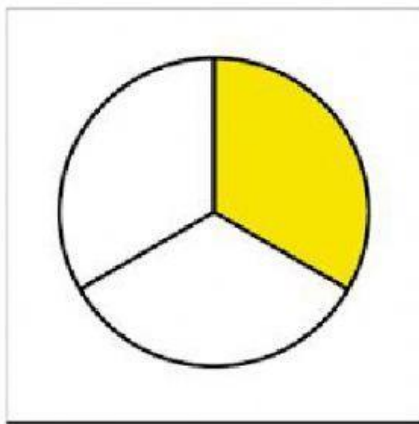
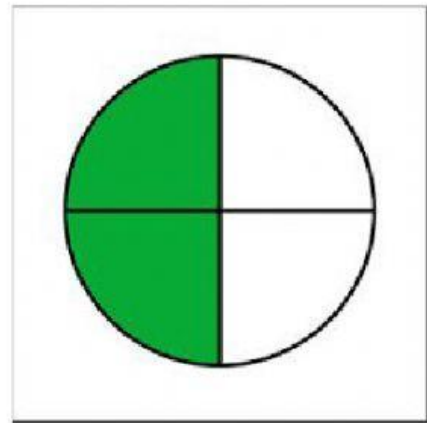
- One is broken into 3 parts and the other is broken into 6 parts.
- The *thirds* are bigger than the *sixths*.



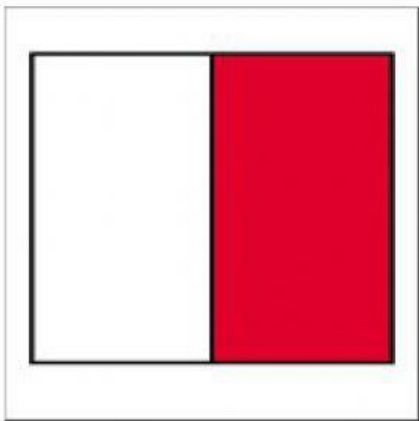
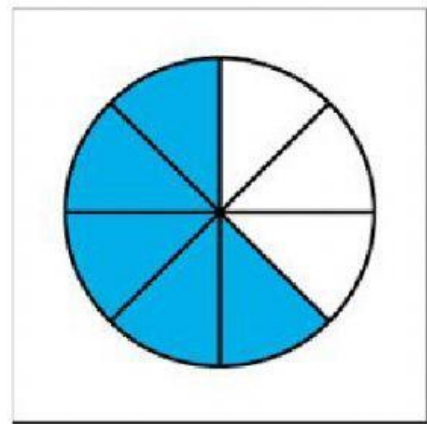
