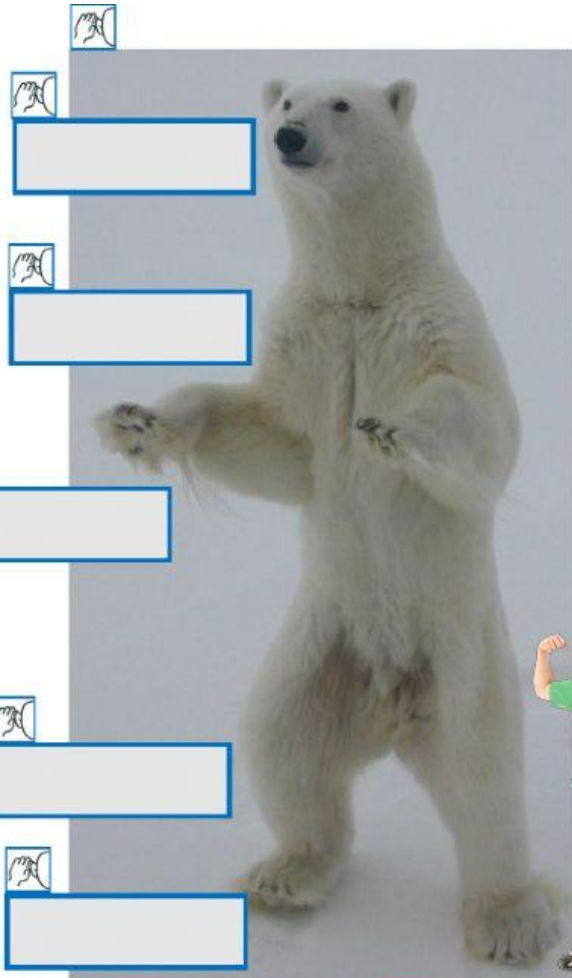

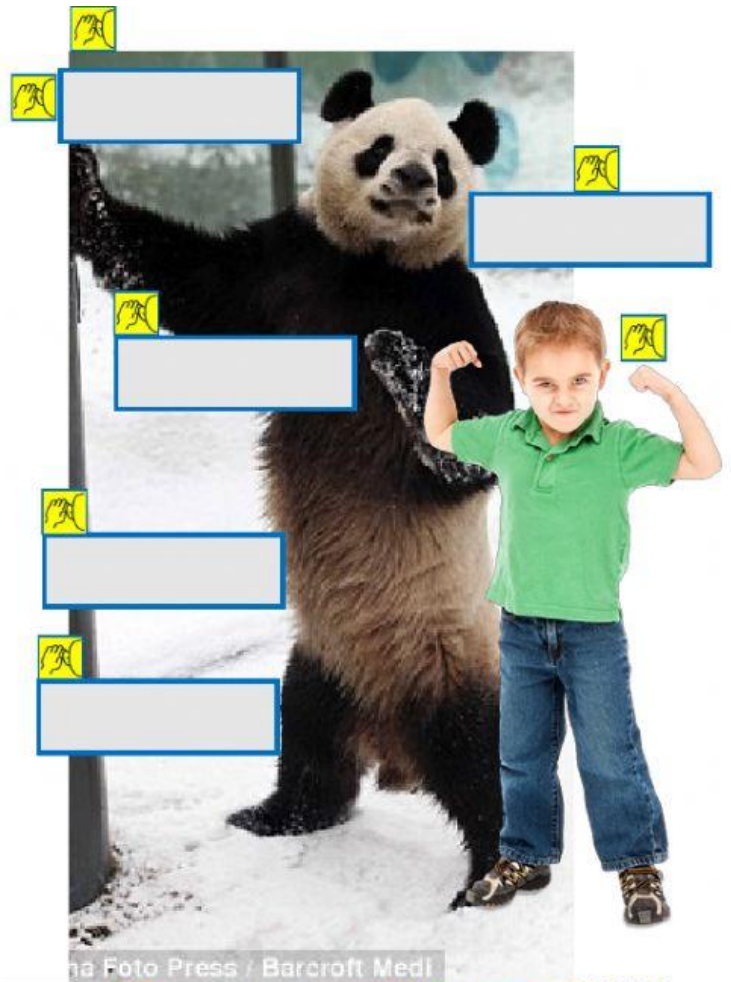

Bamboo is difficult to eat. It has very few calories. Giant pandas eat half of every day. Because they ____ so much, they makes waste up to 100 times a day!

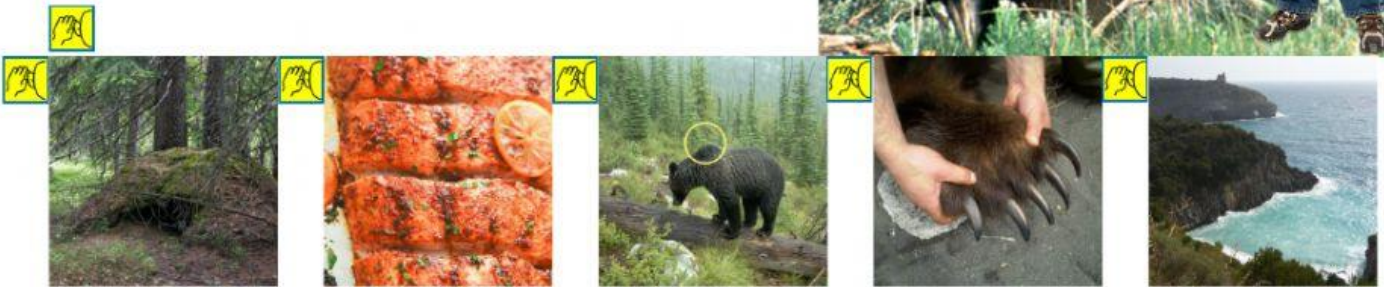
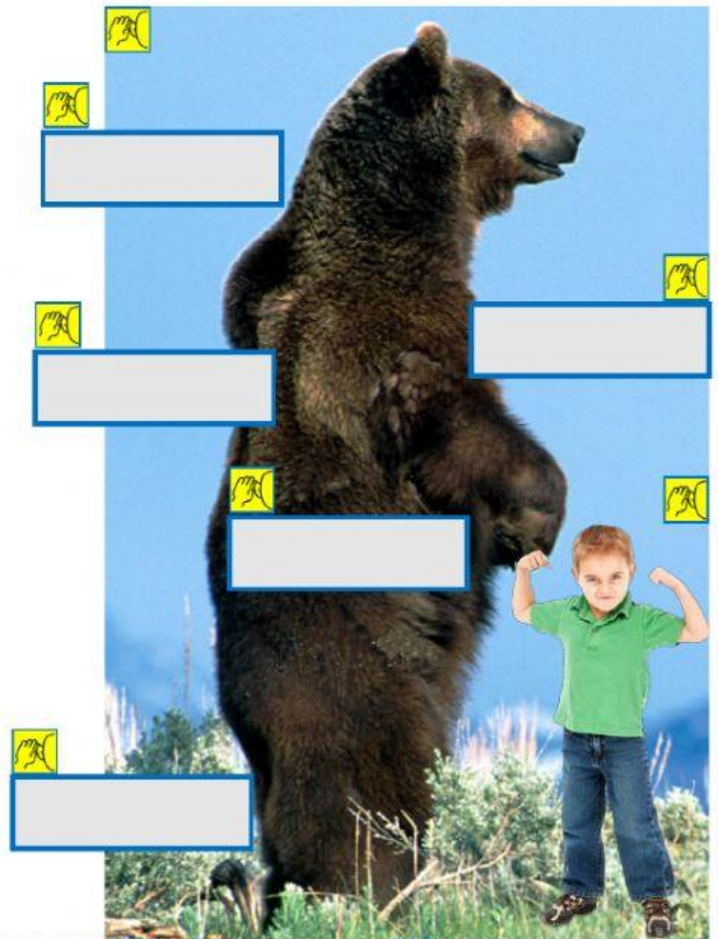

Grizzly bears can live inland or on the **coast**. _____ grizzly bears live away from the **coast**. They live in forest and grassland habitats. They can weigh 270 kilograms and stand 8 feet tall!

Inland grizzlies eat blueberries, eggs, and small animals. Grizzly bears have a special adaptation on their back. They have a **hump** on their back. This **hump** helps make them fast runners. This _____ helps them run more than 60 km/h! Because they are fast, they can catch a big animal, like a moose or caribou!

Some grizzly bears live in **coastal** habitats. The **coast** is a _____ near the ocean. These bears have more food. They can eat lots of **salmon** and other fish. They love **salmon**. Because **coastal** grizzlies eat so much, they get much bigger. **Coastal** grizzly bears can be more than 400 kilograms. They can stand ten feet tall!

Grizzly bears have another famous adaptation. They can hibernate. _____ means sleep for months. They hibernate inside a **den**. Their **den** is a hole under a tree. They dig the hole with their long **claws**. Their **claws** can be five inches long!
