the couch.

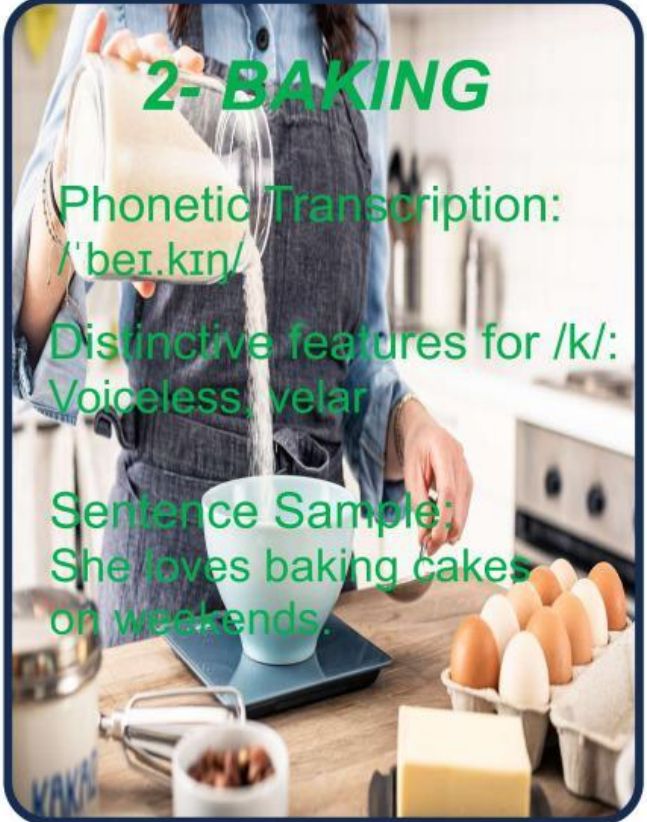


2- BAKING

on weekends.

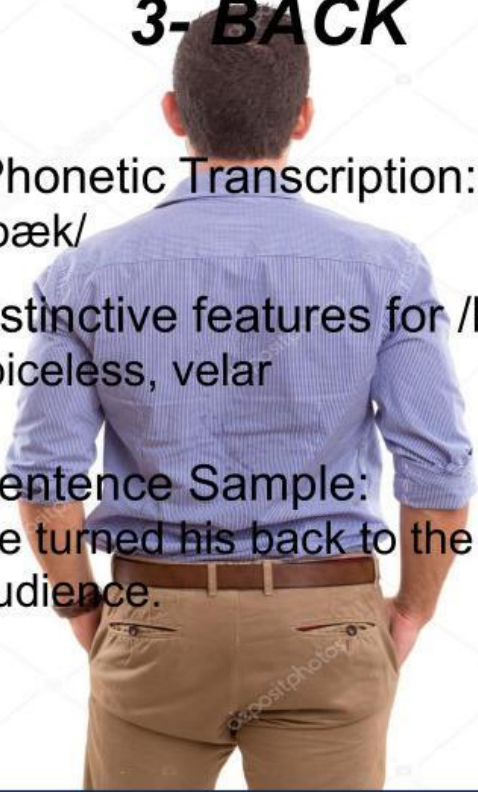


3- BACK

Voiced, velar

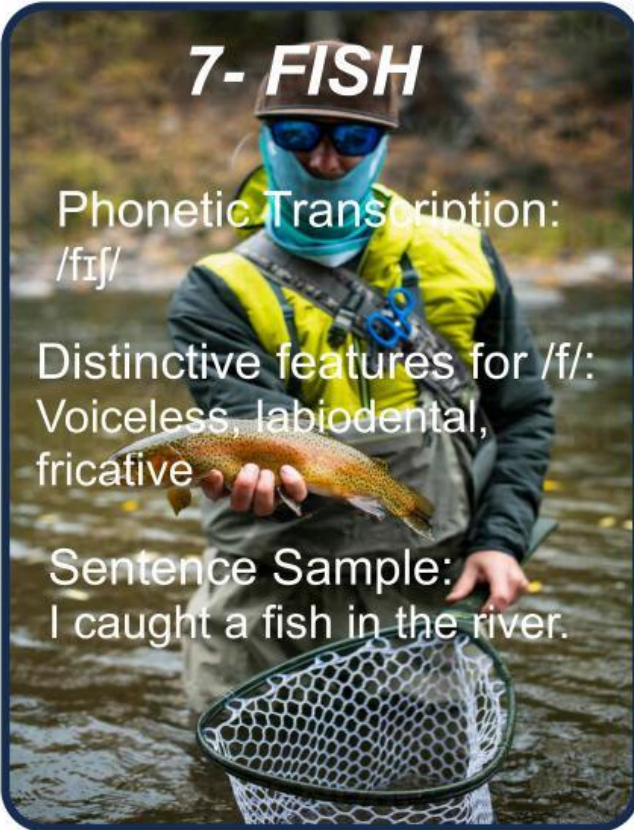
Sentence Sample:

I caught a fish in the river.

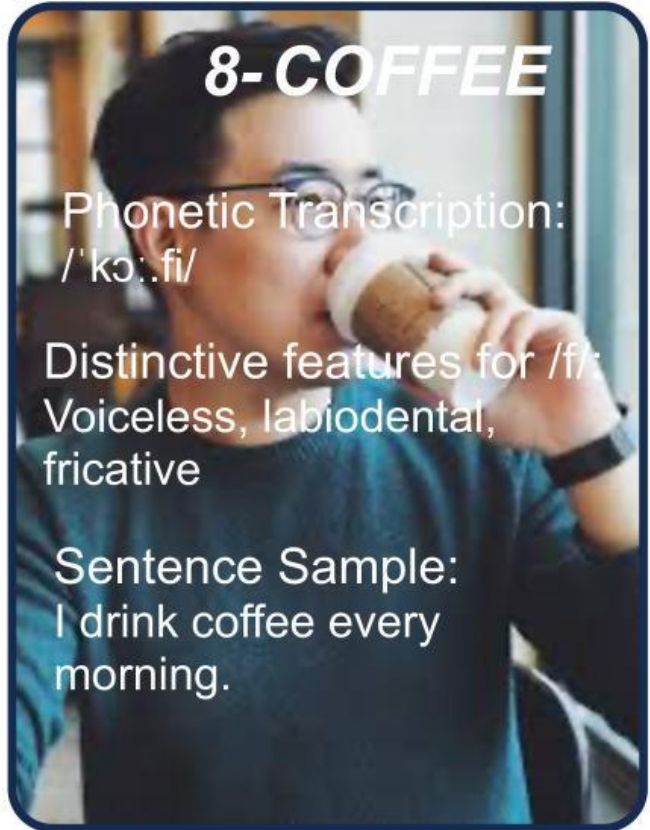


8- COFFEE
