Phonetic transcription: /θɪŋk/

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiceless
I need to **think** carefully about my decision.

Word: thank



Phonetic transcription: /θæŋk/

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiceless
She said, "**Thank** you" after receiving the gift.



Word: thumb

Phonetic transcription: /θʌm/

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiceless
He raised his **thumb** to show approval.

Target Sound: /ð/



Word: this

Phonetic transcription: /ðɪs/

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiced
This is the best day ever!

That

Word: that

Phonetic transcription: /ðæt/

Distinctive features: fricative, dental, voiced

That book is my favorite.



Word: father

Phonetic transcription: /'fɑːðər/

Distinctive features: fricative, dental, voiced

My **father** loves to read newspapers.

Target Sound: /s/



Word: sun

Phonetic transcription: /sʌn/

Distinctive features: fricative, alveolar, voiceless

The **sun** is shining brightly today.



Word: bus

Phonetic transcription: /bʌs/

Distinctive features: Fricative, alveolar, voiceless

She caught the **bus** to school.



Word: fast

Phonetic transcription: /fæst/

Distinctive features: fricative, alveolar, voiceless

He runs **fast** during races.

Target Sound: /z/



Word: zebra

Phonetic transcription: /'zi:brə/

Distinctive features: Fricative, alveolar, voiced

Sentence sample: The **zebra** ran across the field.



Word: zone

Phonetic transcription: /zoun/

Distinctive features: fricative, alveolar, voiced

The park is in the **zone** for sports activities.



Word: music

Phonetic transcription: /'mju:zɪk/

Distinctive features: Fricative, alveolar, voiced

She loves listening to **music** in the evening.
