**Stop, velar, voiceless**

Sentence sample:

**My mom cooks delicious**





# 3. CLOCK

Phonetic transcription:

*/klok/*

Distinctive features for /K/:

Stop, velar, voiceless

Sentence sample:

The clock strikes 3 pm.





# 4. GOAT

Phonetic transcription:


*/gɔʊt/*

Distinctive features for /g/:

Stop, velar, voiced

Sentence sample:

The goat is climbing the hill.

Phonetic transcription:

*/dɒg/*

Distinctive features for /g/:

Stop, velar, voiced

Sentence sample:

My dog loves to play with the ball





## 6. BIG

Phonetic transcription:

*/big/*

Distinctive features for /g/:

*Stop, velar, voiced*

Sentence sample:

*My hamburger is big*

Phonetic transcription:

/fɪʃ/




Distinctive features for /f/:

Fricative, labiodental, voiceless

Sentence sample:

The fish is swimming in the sea.

Phonetic transcription:


**/kofi/**

*/ɪnvaɪt/*


Distinctive features for /v/:
