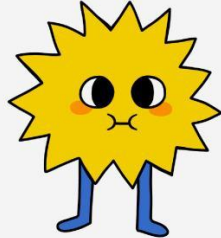

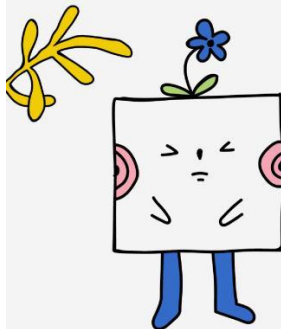
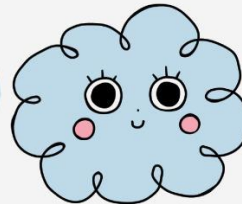

PLACE OF ARTICULATION

Labio-dental

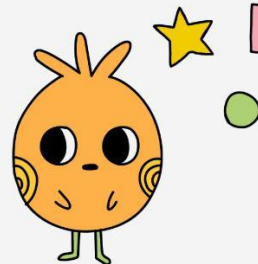
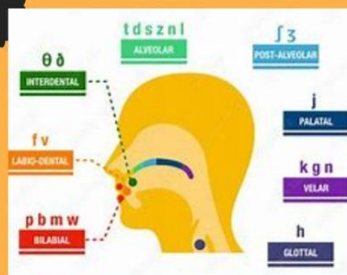
Labio-dental sounds are made by placing the upper teeth on top of the lower lip.



MANNER OF ARTICULATION

The air creates a noisy sound as it blows through the mouth. An example of this is when you produce F /f/ and V /v/ by forcing air through the narrow space between the top teeth and bottom lip.
