
TIME IS AN ILLUSION, MORTY!

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PREPOSITIONS OF TIME: 'AT', 'IN', 'ON'

Prepositions of time tell us when something happens



AT

AT + specific time
AT + Holiday period

Used for:

Exact times – *at 3:00 PM, at midnight*
Holidays/nights – *at night, at Christmas*
Fixed expressions – *at the weekend*

IN

IN + Months
IN + Years
IN + the + Decade
IN + Season
IN + the + century

Used for:

Months – *in July, in December*
Years – *in 2023, in 3012*
Seasons – *in summer, in winter*
Parts of the day – *in the morning, in the evening (but NOT at night).*



ON

ON + Days
ON + Dates



Days of the week – *on Monday, on Friday*

Specific dates – *on July 4th, on December 25th*

Day + part of the day – *on Tuesday night, on Sunday morning*

<u>Preposition</u>	<u>Usage</u>	<u>Example</u>
<u>IN</u>	months, years, seasons	"In 3020, Earth is a wasteland."
<u>ON</u>	days, dates	"On Monday, Beth shot a clone of herself."
<u>AT</u>	exact times, nights	"At midnight, Rick invented a new curse word."
X <u>NONE</u>	next/last/this/every	"This year, Jerry got divorced... again."

We don't use Prepositions when...



Remember! We do not use **at, on, in** with
the following expressions:

<i>Today</i>	<i>Tomorrow</i>	<i>Yesterday</i>	<i>This morning</i>
<i>Tonight</i>	<i>Last</i>	<i>Next</i>	<i>Every</i>


