

# Israelites Leave Egypt – Crossing the Red Sea

- Where did God lead the Israelites?
  - Through the snow
  - Through the wilderness toward the Red Sea
  - Through the desert toward the Sea of Galilee
- Why did God send the Israelites the long way out of Egypt?
  - If they faced a battle, they might change their minds and go back to Egypt
  - The shortcut had many obstacles
  - So they would trust God
- What did Moses take with him when he fled Egypt?
  - 10 bags of silver
  - The bones of Joseph
  - The golden crown
- Where was Etham?
  - At the bottom of Mount Saini
  - In the valley of dry bones
  - On the edge of the wilderness
- How did God lead Moses and the Israelites?
  - A ray of light by night & mighty winds by day
  - A pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night
  - A fog-like haze
- What did Pharaoh and the officials of Egypt do after the Israelites fled Egypt?
  - Sent them a farewell letter
  - Threw a huge party
  - Changed their minds/regretted letting them go
- What happened when Pharaoh & the Egyptians chased the Israelites into the Red Sea?
  - They were able to travel on dry ground to get to them
  - Moses lowered his staff and the waters fell back into place wiping out Pharaoh and his entire army
  - They fell on their swords
- What did the Lord tell Moses to do when they reached the Red Sea?
  - Raise his staff over the water and turn it into blood
  - Throw his staff on the ground and it turned into a snake
  - Raise his staff over the sea and divide the water so the people can walk through on dry ground
- What does the word “Marah” mean?
  - Bitter
  - Sweet
  - Hot
- Why did Moses take Joseph’s bones with them?
  - He didn’t want to leave him behind
  - Joseph had asked him to take him away from Egypt
  - He wanted Joseph to experience the land of God’s promise
- How did the Lord rescue the people of Israel from the Egyptians?
  - Allowed them to walk on water
  - Provided a boat for them to cross the sea
  - Allowed them to walk through the middle of the sea on dry ground
- What did Moses and the people of Israel do after they crossed the Red Sea?
  - Sang a song to the Lord
  - Had a meal
  - Camped out for the night
- What did the Israelites find at the Oasis of Elim?
  - Tents and a campfire
  - Springs and palm trees
  - A hot meal and their families
- What did Moses do to the water to make it good to drink?
  - Purified it by boiling it
  - Threw a piece of wood into the water
  - Lowered his staff into the water
- What did God command of the Israelites to protect them from harm?
  - To never question His authority
  - For them to remain thankful
  - To listen and obey the voice of the Lord their God and do what is right in His sight
- What happened to the water when Moses split the sea?
  - The waters stood up like a wall on both sides**
  - It turned to blood
  - The waters in the whole sea dried up
