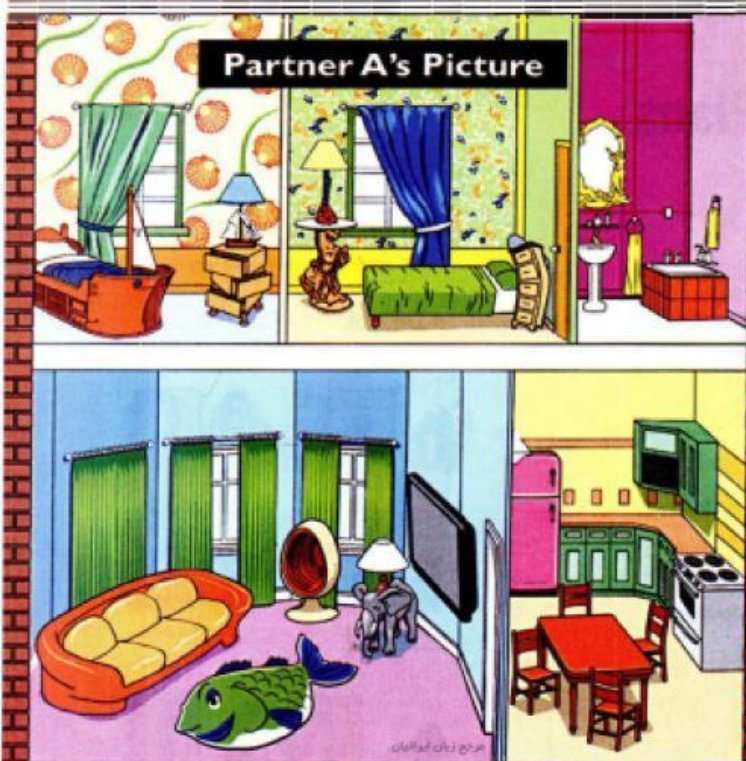


Partner A's Picture

Upstairs, there are two small bedrooms and a small bathroom.

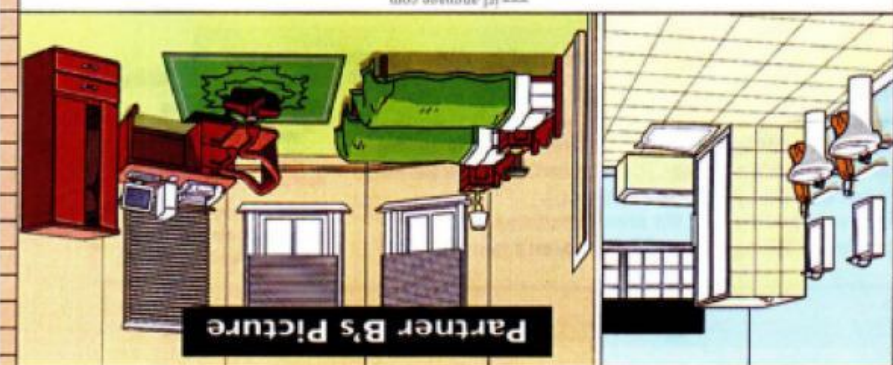
