MANY = hodně, mnoho – with Countables (s počitatelnými podst. jmény)

- Obojí typicky použijeme v **otázce** a **záporné** větě.

A LOT OF = hodně, mnoho – with Countables and Uncountables

- Typicky použijeme v **kladné oznamovací** větě
