- Gold is often used in machines, like computers, because electricity can move through it easily.

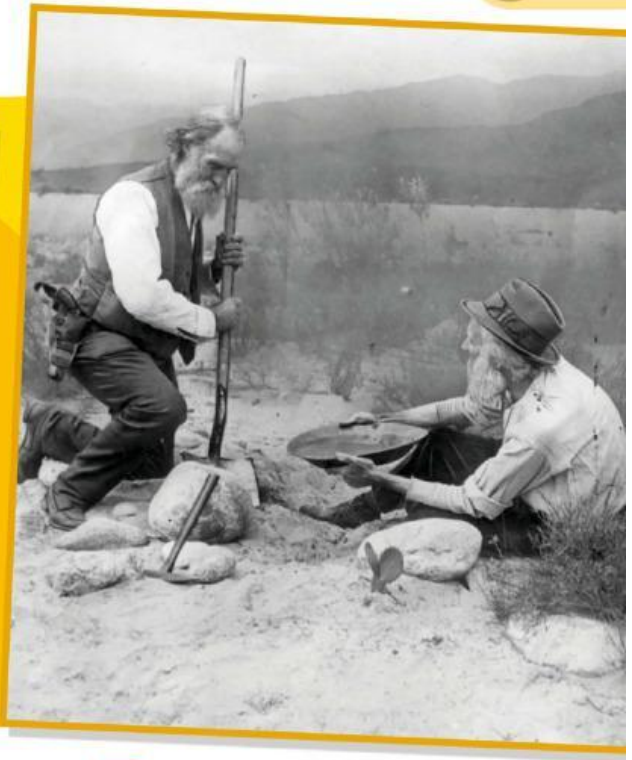
