Family Roles and Responsibilities

In many families today, both parents work outside the home, and housework is shared among all family members. Fathers may help with cooking or cleaning, while mothers may also work full-time jobs. Children, too, can contribute by setting the table, washing dishes, or taking out the trash.

By working together, families can create a supportive and loving environment where everyone plays a role. Whether someone is a breadwinner or a homemaker, doing housework or handling heavy lifting, every task is important in maintaining a happy and functional home.
