These days, many young people spend several hours a day on social media platforms like Instagram, TikTok, and Snapchat. These platforms are not just for fun—they're also a way to communicate, learn, and even create content. With just a few taps, users can scroll through hundreds of posts, like photos, watch videos, or react to stories.

For 17-year-old Mia, social media is part of her everyday life. "I usually check my apps as soon as I wake up," she says. "First, I scroll through TikTok to watch new videos. Then I open Instagram and check my DMs to see if any friends have sent me a message during the night."
