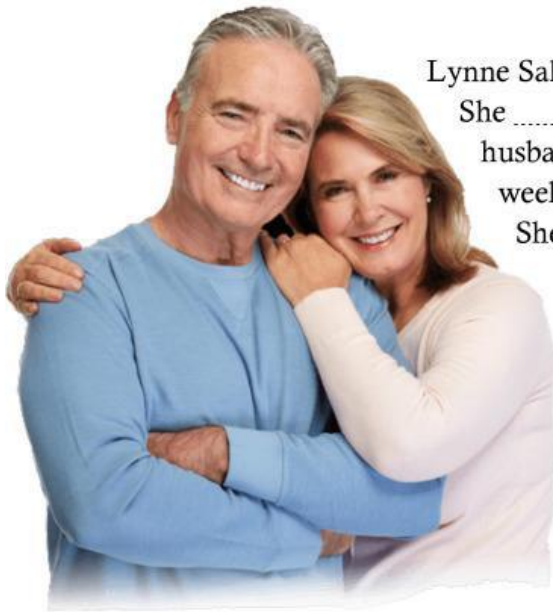


Present Simple
