Subject Pronouns – Pronomes Pessoais do Caso Reto (Sujeito) e

Object Pronouns – Pronomes Pessoais do Caso Oblíquo (Objeto)

O Pronome é a classe de palavras que acompanha ou substitui um substantivo ou um outro pronome, indicando sua posição em relação às pessoas do discurso ou mesmo situando-o no espaço e no tempo.

Os pronomes nos ajudam a evitar repetições desnecessárias na fala e na escrita.

Caso Reto (Sujeito)	
Subject Pronoun	
I (eu)	
you (tu, você)	
he (ele)	He- usado para o masculino. Ex. Pedro (He = ele)
she (ela)	She- usado para o feminino. Ex. Ana (She = ela)
it (ele, ela [neutro])	It- usado para animais e objetos em geral. Ex. Dog (It =ele) Pencil (It = ele)
we (nós)	We- udaso com I (EU) + outra pessoa You (você) = We (nós)Ex I and Marcos are Brothers. (We = nos)
you (vocês, vós)	
they (eles, elas)	They- usado de quem se fala. Ex. Marcos , Pedro and Ana are late today. They are late today.

Os Pronomes Pessoais do Caso Reto desempenham papel de **sujeito (subject) da oração:**

1-**Michel** is happy. (Ele está happy.) Ele = **Michel**

2-**Mary** is sad. (Ela está triste.) Ela = **Mary**

3-**Carlos and I** are friends. (Carlos e eu somos amigos) Nós = **Carlos e eu**

4-**Ana and Clara** are friends. (Ana e Clara são amigas) Nós = **Ana e Clara**

5-My **dog** is black and white. (Meu cachorro é preto e branco) It = **dog**

6- My **dog** and **cat** are black.(Meu cachorro e gato são preto.) They= (**dog e cat**) They are black.

Subject Pronoun	Object Pronoun
<i>I</i> (eu)	<i>me</i> (me, mim)
<i>you</i> (tu, você)	<i>you</i> (lhe, o, a, te, ti, a você)
<i>he</i> (ele)	<i>him</i> (lhe, o, a ele)
<i>she</i> (ela)	<i>her</i> (lhe, a, a ela)
<i>it</i> (ele, ela [neutro])	<i>it</i> (lhe, o, a)
<i>we</i> (nós)	<i>us</i> (nos)
<i>you</i> (vocês, vós)	<i>you</i> (vos, lhes, a vocês)
<i>they</i> (eles, elas)	<i>them</i> (lhes, os, as)

1-They know **Julia**. (Eles conhecem Julia. **Julia** = HER)
They know her.(**Eles a conhecem.**)

2-She Works for **Mike**. (Ela trabalha para Mike) **Mike** = HIM
She Works for him. (Ela trabalha para ele)

3-They eat **pizza** every night.(Eles comem pizza toda noite)
They eat **it** every night.
