

Vertex Point Indicator for MetaTrader 4 Download - Free - [TFlab]



The **Vertex Point Indicator**, one of the **MetaTrader 4 indicators**, analyzes **volume** and **trend strength**.

This tool employs colored bars around the zero level to display **buy** and **sell** conditions. **Blue bars** indicate buying volume in this indicator, and **red bars** represent selling volume.



Vertex Point Indicator Specifications

Uptrend Analysis of the Indicator

In the **NZD/CAD currency pair** chart, the price reaches the **oversold zone**, and the indicator histogram approaches the oscillator's negative **10 level**.

In this situation, traders can enter a **buy trade** upon observing suitable candlestick confirmation.



Analysis of Vertex Point Indicator in an uptrend

Downtrend Analysis of the Indicator

In the **GBP/JPY** currency pair chart on a **30-minute timeframe**, after an uptrend ends, the price reaches the **overbought zone**.

Here, the indicator's **blue bar** touches the **10 levels** in its window, prompting traders to enter a **sell** trade.

Indicator Settings

The settings section of the indicator is fully illustrated in the following image:



Display of Vertex Point Indicator Settings

- ⚡ **Period Of Calculation:** Defines the number of calculation periods for the indicator
- ⚡ **Theme:** Background theme of the indicator

Conclusion

Vertex Points are key concepts in **technical analysis**. They are used to identify **reversal zones** or **trend continuation** areas on price charts.

These zones often appear at significant **support** or **resistance levels**, providing valuable information about price behavior. Traders can use **support and resistance indicators** to identify these zones effectively.
