

Prepositions & Prepositional Phrases

A **preposition** shows the relationship between a noun or pronoun and other words in a sentence, typically indicating location, time, or direction.

A **Prepositional Phrase** is a group of words that includes a preposition, its object (a noun, pronoun, or noun phrase), and any words that modify the object
