We use the Present Simple Tense when talking about things that happen regularly or facts that are always true.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I eat.	I don't eat.	Do I eat?
You eat.	You don't eat.	Do you eat?
We eat.	We don't eat.	Do we eat?
They eat.	They don't eat.	Do they eat?
He eats.	He <b>doesn't</b> eat.	<b>Does</b> he eat?
She eats.	She <b>doesn't</b> eat.	<b>Does</b> she eat?
It eats.	It <b>doesn't</b> eat.	<b>Does</b> it eat?
