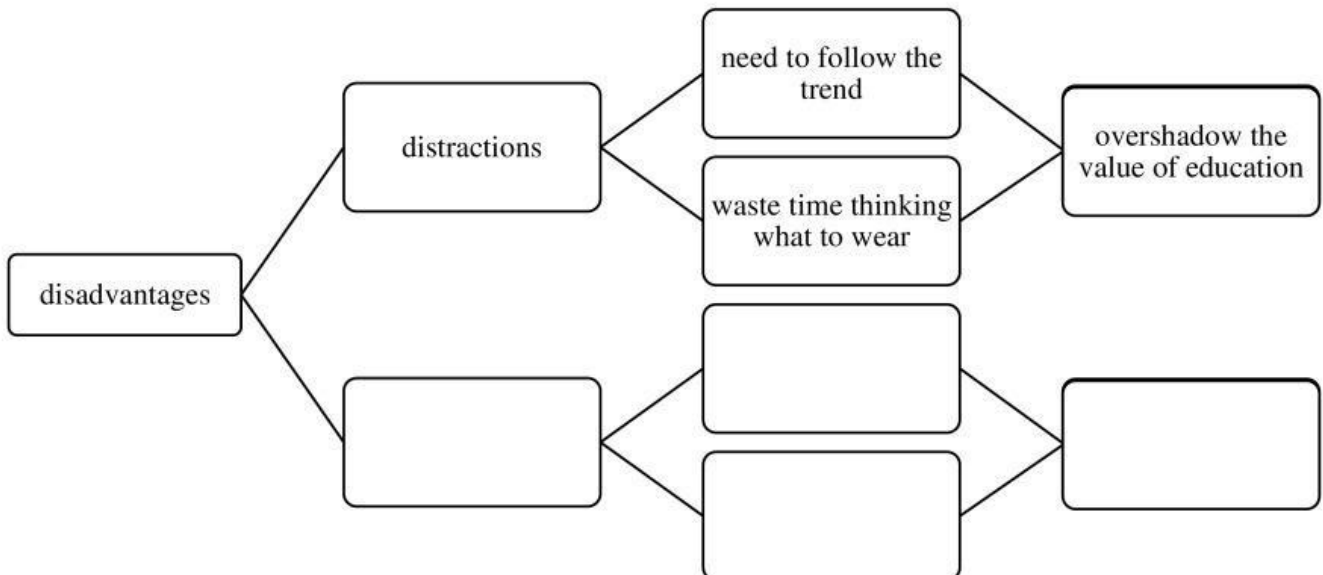
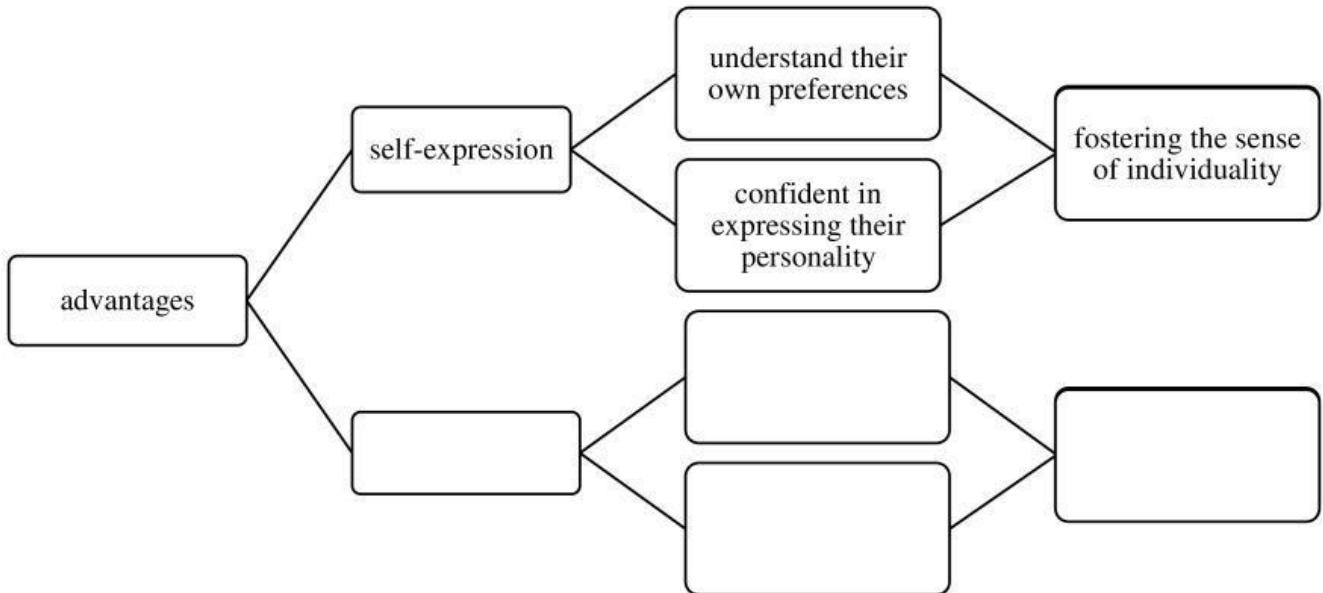
Rafting on the Zambezi River
