



BUSY BEES



Bees are small insects that play a big role in our world. They help plants grow by moving pollen from one flower to another. This process, called pollination, helps fruits, vegetables, and nuts grow. In fact, about one-third of the food we eat depends on bees.

Bees also support nature. They help wild plants grow, which provide food and homes for other animals. Without bees, many plants and animals would struggle to survive.

Unfortunately, bee populations are declining. This is due to habitat loss, pesticide use, diseases, and climate change. To help bees, we can:

- Plant a variety of flowers that bloom at different times of the year.
 - Avoid using harmful chemicals in our gardens.
 - Support local beekeepers by buying their honey.
 - Provide nesting sites by leaving some areas of our gardens wild.
