

Animal Habitats

A habitat is the place where an animal lives.



The **forest** is a cool, dark habitat with a lot of trees. Deer, raccoons, and foxes live there. Forests cover **8%** / **28%** of the planet.



6% / **60%** of our planet is **desert**. It's hot in the day and cold at night. There isn't much rain, so it's very dry, and there aren't many plants. Lizards and snakes live there.

The **ocean** covers **21%** / **71%** of our planet, and the water in it is salty. Many kinds of fish live in the ocean. Other animals live there, too, like whales and seals.



It's hot in the **jungle**, and it rains a lot. Monkeys, colorful birds, and butterflies live there. There are tigers, too! The jungle covers only **2%** / **12%** of the planet, but 50% of all plant and animal species live there.
