Basic form

Subject + Verb past form

I	worked.
You	ate.
He	studied.
She	spoke.
It	ran.
We	destroyed.
They	played.

Subject + verb (past form) + direct object + complement

✱ **Cadets ate cookies in English class .**

✱ **Peter brushed his teeth at 5:00 am .**

2 AFFIRMATIVE USING SIGNAL WORDS

Subject + verb (past form) + direct object + complement + signal word.

✱ **Cadets shaved their faces in the barracks yesterday.**

✱ **Peter took a shower in his house last weekend.**
