A powered flying machine with fixed wings that travels long distances through the air.
Transports people and cargo between cities or countries.
Takes off from and lands on runways at airports.

A vehicle used to carry injured or sick people to medical help quickly.

3. _____

An aircraft that flies using rotating blades on top.
Can take off and land vertically.
