The Ten Plagues of Egypt



The ten plagues were sent to show Pharaoh and the Egyptians how powerless their gods were compared to YHWH. Even the Egyptian magicians could not copy most of these plagues. The plague of frogs was judgment against Heqet, the Egyptian frog-headed goddess of birth. The plague of locusts was against the Egyptian god, Osiris, who was considered 'lord of lords and king of kings.' The plague of darkness was a judgment against Rah, the Egyptian sun god. The plague of lice attacked the Egyptians' obsession with cleanliness.
