



PRESENT PERFECT

We use the Present Perfect Tense when talking about actions that happened at some point in the past and are important now.

| POSITIVE | NEGATIVE | QUESTION |
|-----------------------|--------------------------|-----------------------|
| I have eaten. | I haven't eaten. | Have I eaten? |
| You have eaten. | You haven't eaten. | Have you eaten? |
| We have eaten. | We haven't eaten. | Have we eaten? |
| They have eaten. | They haven't eaten. | Have they eaten? |
| He has eaten. | He hasn't eaten. | Has he eaten? |
| She has eaten. | She hasn't eaten. | Has she eaten? |
| It has eaten. | It hasn't eaten. | Has it eaten? |
