The verb changes in 3rd person singular (he, she, it).

We add **-s**  
run - runs eat - eats

Add **-es** when the verb ends in  
**-ss -sh -ch -x -z or -o**

fix - fixes go - goes  
wash - washes

When the verb ends in  
**consonant + y**

cry - cries  
study - studies  
dry - dries

tidy - tidies  
fly - flies  
copy - copies
