Activity 2

Text 1 Orientation

Long ago, before the world was ruled by gods, the universe was controlled by the mighty Titans, led by Cronus, the Titan King. Cronus was powerful, but he feared a prophecy that said one of his children would overthrow him. To prevent this, he swallowed each of his children the moment they were born.

Text 2 Orientation

Zeus is one of the most powerful gods in Greek mythology. He is often depicted as a tall, muscular figure, with a regal presence that demands respect. His skin shines with the brilliance of the sky, and his long, flowing beard gives him an air of wisdom and authority. In his right hand, he holds a massive thunderbolt, which symbolizes his dominion over the heavens and the earth.

Text 1 Complication

However, his wife, Rhea, could not bear to lose another child. When she gave birth to her youngest son, Zeus, she tricked Cronus by wrapping a stone in cloth and giving it to him instead. Text 1 Complication
