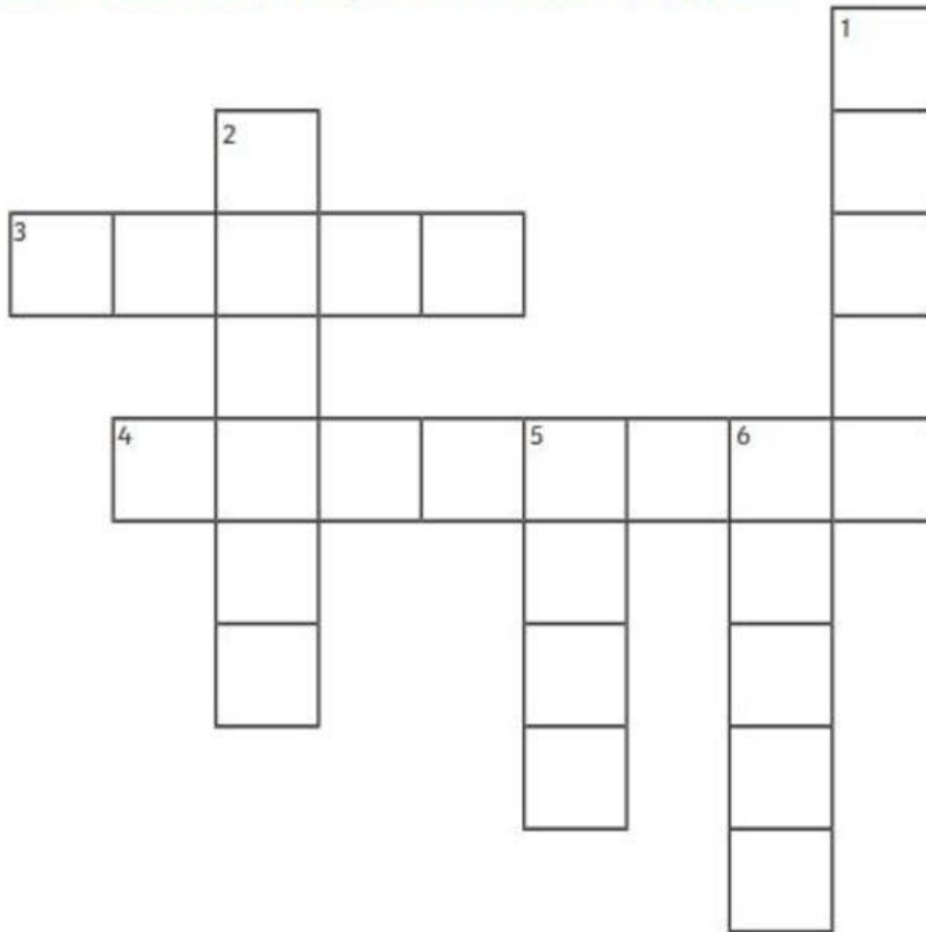




Activity 1: Read the clues and complete the crossword puzzle.
