

Resumão Língua Inglesa – Inglês Iniciante.

Verbo to be - Simple tense

O VERBO TO BE - SIMPLE TENSE, indica algo do presente que É(SER) ou ESTÁ(ESTAR). Você pode usar AM, IS ou ARE, dependendo do sujeito.

FORMA AFIRMATIVA

I am (eu sou/ eu estou)

You are (você é/ você está)

He is (ele é/ ele está)

She is (ela é/ ela está)

It is (ele(a) é/ ele(a) está) **NEUTRO** = apenas para animais, objetos ou coisas.

You are (vocês são/ vocês estão) **OBS.** este sujeito pode estar no singular ou no plural, depende do **SUBSTANTIVO**.

We are (nós somos/ nós estamos)

They are (eles(as) são/ eles(elas) estão)

FORMA NEGATIVA

I am not (ou I'm not) (eu não sou/ eu não estou)

You are not (ou You aren't) (você não é/ você não está)

He is not (ou He isn't) (ele não é/ ele não está)

She is not (ou She isn't) (ela não é/ ela não está)

It is not (ou It isn't) (ele(a) não é/ ele(a) não está) (**NEUTRO** = apenas para animais, objetos ou coisas).

We are not (ou We aren't) (nós não somos/ nós não estamos)

You are not (ou You aren't) (vocês não são/ vocês não estão) **OBS.** este sujeito pode estar no singular ou no plural, depende do **SUBSTANTIVO**.

They are not (ou They aren't) (eles(as) não são/ eles(as) não estão)

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

O Present Continuous indica uma ação habitual pelo sujeito, uma ação que está em progressão, ou seja, algo e/ou uma ação que está acontecendo. No present continuous, o verbo auxiliar é o TO BE (seja no presente ou no passado) e o verbo principal é o acrescentado de ING no final. O Presente Continuous é o velho gerúndio conhecido na Língua Portuguesa.

Regras

1. Quando o verbo for monossílabo e terminar com consoante-vogal-consoante (CVC), duplica-se a consoante + ING.

Ex: JOG ----> JOGGING

RUN ----> RUNNING

✓ She **is** running at the round of the house.

2. Verbos terminados em E, acompanhado de vogal, exclui-se as vogais e acrescenta-se Y+ING.

Ex:

LIE ----> LYING

DIE ----> DYING

✓ Lidiane **is** tying the her shoes.

3. Verbos terminados em E, acompanhado de consoante, exclui-se o mesmo, e acrescenta-se ING.

Ex:

WRITE ----> WRITING

CHANGE ----> CHANGING

DANCE ----> DANCING

✓ Mr. Silva **is** writing a poem.

4. Verbos terminados em Y, acrescenta-se apenas ING.

Ex:

PLAY ----> PLAYING

STUDY ----> STUDYING

CRY ----> CRYING

✓ She **was** crying because she was very sad.

5. Verbos terminados em SS, SH, X, O E CH, acrescenta-se apenas ING.

Ex:

WASH ----> WASHING

WATCH ----> WATCHING

BOX ----> BOXING

DO ----> DOING

✓ Mrs. Brown **was** washing the dishes yesterday.

You		aren't	+	working	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »

Example: He **is not (isn't)** working in the garden.

1. Add **-ing** to most verbs
start - starting
jump - jumping
2. If the verb ends in **e**
cut **e** add **ing**
not for -ie or -ee
live - living
care - caring
3. If the verb ends in **ee**
add **ing**
see - seeing
agree - agreeing
4. If the verb ends in **ie**
cut **ie** add **y** then add **ing**
die - dying
tie - tying
5. One syllable verbs and ends
consonant + vowel + consonant
Double the last consonant and add **ing**
run - running
stop - stopping
6. Do not double if final letter is
w, x, y
play - playing
sew - sewing
mix - mixing
