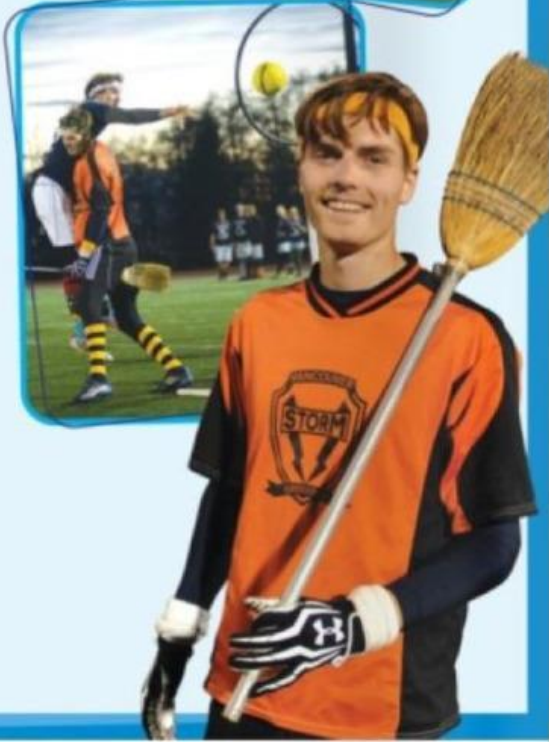

Hi everyone! I'm sure that you all know of British writer J. K. Rowling's famous books about Harry Potter. My parents bought me the first one two years ago and I immediately became a huge fan! In the books, Harry goes to a school for wizards. He learns about magic and plays a sport called quidditch. He's really good at it. You probably saw him win a match or two in the films, but I bet you didn't know that you can play quidditch in real life! It started here in Vermont, USA in 2005. Now, there's a US Quidditch organisation with more than 100 teams. There's even a quidditch club at my school and I joined last month. It's brilliant!

When I arrived at my first practice, the captain of the team gave me a broomstick. We can't fly them like in the books, of course, but I quickly learned to run around with one between my legs! We play on a grass pitch with three hoops at each end, and there are seven players on the team: one seeker, three chasers, two beaters and one keeper. The aim is to score points. The chasers try to throw a ball through one of the hoops to score 10 points. The beaters try to stop them and the keeper guards the hoops. After 18 minutes, the snitch comes out. In the books, the snitch is a golden flying ball. In real life, it's a tennis ball in a long sock that hangs behind the shorts of the snitch runner! The seeker – that's me – catches the snitch and throws it through a hoop. This gets 30 points and the game ends. I was thrilled last week when I played my first game and caught the snitch. My team won!
