# Reported Questions



| direct question            | reported question           |
|----------------------------|-----------------------------|
| She said: "Are you cold?"  | She asked me if I was cold. |
| He said: "Where's my pen?" | He asked where his pen was. |

Reported questions are one form of reported speech.

We usually introduce reported questions with the verb "ask":

- He asked (me) if/whether... (YES/NO questions)
- He asked (me) why/when/where/what/how... (Question Word questions)
