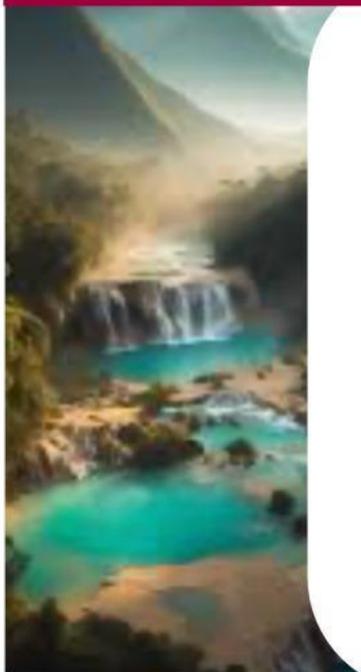


## What is the best way to travel across Guatemala.? Do you agree to these answers?
