

Comparative Adjectives

- 1 **ADD -ER:**
Add -er to one-syllable adjectives.
Example: Clean → Cleaner
- 2 **ADD -IER:**
Change the "y" to "i" and add -er when the adjective ends in "y."
Example: Funny → Funnier
- 3 **DOUBLE CONSONANT + -ER:**
Double the last consonant and add -er to one-syllable adjectives ending in consonant + vowel + consonant.
Example: Hot → Hotter
- 4 **ADD "MORE":**
Add "more" before long adjectives.
Example: Boring → More boring
- 5 **IRREGULAR ADJECTIVES:**
Some adjectives have irregular comparative forms.
Examples: Good → Better, Bad → Worse
